How will the funds be spent to support those affected by the drought?

The purpose: the funds raised will be spent to support families in affected by the drought by providing cash support of 80 USD (ca. 600 DKK) to families, which is expected to cover their basic needs for a month. One of the organizations, Rajo Organization will in addition spend the funds to repair a dam.

1. The collection of funds will end by the **15th December 2022**. After this date, we will begin to transfer donations to our four local partners.
2. Together we have access to regions across Somaliland and Somalia through our local partners. We will **divide the funds equally between us**, one fourth each. We will work with our local partners to identify families who are in most need of support following the below selection criteria:
 - a. People with mental disorders.
 - b. Disabled
 - c. Malnourished children
 - d. Orphan
 - e. Elderly
 - f. Widows
 - g. Single mothers
 - h. Lactating mothers
3. To identify and select the families according to the selection criteria will receive support and **coordinate** with our local partners, the local community committees, elders and the local authorities. For the selection we will register people using their names, genders, age

and number of children in each household. The target villagers will be clearly informed that the aim of this distribution is to support the most vulnerable families.

4. As such, our local partners will then collaborate with a Somali MobilePay company regarding dates and amount to be transferred to the recipients. Each family will receive **80 USD (ca. 600 DKK)** which is expected to cover their basic needs for a month.
5. We will verify the recipient's MobilePay numbers using the MobilePay system. The amount will be transferred on their MobilePay for the selected families. It is expected that the transfer of funds to families will take approximately **1-2 weeks**. As such, activities are expected to begin **January 1st 2023**.
6. **One month** after the cash transfer, we and our local partners will follow up with a monitoring to ensure they have been allocated the correct funding. Our local partner will contact each recipient to verify receipt of the funds.

All four diaspora organizations have experience implementing development and relief projects. We have previously implemented projects with funding from the Danish Refugee Council (DRC), the Danish Emergency Relief Fund (DERF), Globus (previous Genbrug til Syd) and Civil Samfund i Udvikling (CISU).
