

## **This event is organized by the following four Somali diaspora-led organizations in Denmark:**

### **Iftin Organization**

Founded in 2013, Iftin organization supports Somalis in Denmark and Somaliland in collaboration with their local partner ARD and SYRO.

Their development work focuses on creating projects for marginalized groups in Denmark as well as grassroots engagement directly from affected people in Somaliland., with a specific focus on economic, health, environmental, cultural and gender-related issues.

### **Southern Somalia Peace and Development Organization (SSPDO)**

Founded in 2007, SSPDO is an independent non-political, non-religious organization that aims to strengthen peace and development in Somalia as well as promote the inclusion and integration challenges that the Somali community is facing in Denmark.

### **Hayaan organization**

Hayaan Somaliland Humanitarian organization is a Danish association and was founded in 2011. Hayaan provides capacity-building efforts, reconstruction projects and fundraising initiatives that provide support to vulnerable groups in Somaliland with a particular focus on unemployed youth empowerment and vulnerable families.

### **Rajo Organization**

Rajo Organization is a Danish-Somali non-profit organization established in 2000. In the first 10 years, Rajo focused primarily on supporting integration initiatives and working closely with the Somali community in Denmark. Since 2010, Rajo has shifted its focus, and has since provided humanitarian aid and supported sustainable development in Somaliland
