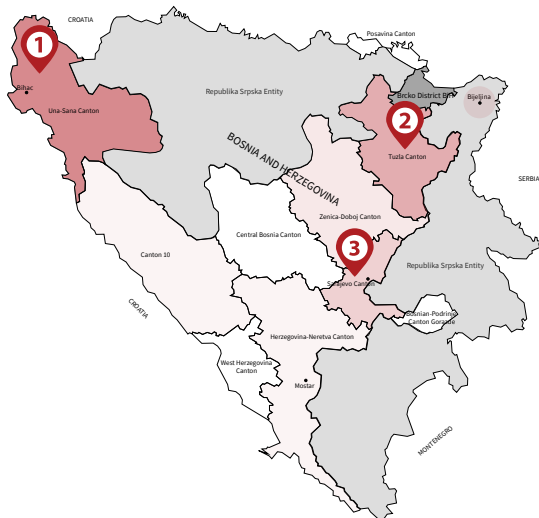


# WINTER IS COMING

For asylum-seekers and migrants without access to reception facilities and stranded in informal accommodation and exposed to harsh weather conditions DRC outreach protection teams provide emergency life-saving assistance. DRC mobile teams ensure a regular protection presence in outside of centers in informal locations, and ensure identification of vulnerable cases and their referral to reception facilities. Through mobile medical teams established in partnership with the Red Cross Society of the Federation of BiH, DRC ensures emergency medical response for persons sleeping rough without access to reception facilities.



**TO MITIGATE THE RISKS OF HARSH WINTER,**  
we still need to ensure food and other essential items, such as personal hygiene packages, sleeping bags, winter clothes and shoes, blankets for persons stranded outside of reception facilities.
