Hellenic Integration Support For Beneficiaries of International Protection (HELIOS)

DRC Greece is collaborating with the International Organization for Migration (IOM) Greece for the implementation of HELIOS project, which is funded by the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund of the European Union¹.

The project aims at promoting the integration of beneficiaries of international protection into the Greek society through a multi-component approach comprising of integration courses, accommodation and employability support, integration monitoring and sensitization of the host community.

Being part of the education pillar, DRC Greece is responsible for setting up four (4) Integration Learning Centres across Greece (Athens, Karditsa, Larissa, Trikala) and for offering integration courses to beneficiaries. Each course cycle runs for 6 months and consists of inter-linked modules, namely Greek language learning (including support to receive certification) and soft skills (cultural orientation, life skills, job readiness).
