1	08-04-2021	What is the geographic locations covered by this project?	Amman, Mafraq, Zarqa, Ajloun, Irbid, Karak, Ma'an, Tafilah, Azraq, Jerash
2	08-04-2021	Is it DRC responsibility to provide the company with support letters while performing the procedures with other formal parties and authorities?	DRC will help provide you with contact information. If a letter is needed, we can draft one, but this is only if the initial contact information is not sufficient. Most formal parties will already have a relationship with DRC through RYSE.
3	08-04-2021	During the evaluation assignment (process evaluation) we suggest using the following drivers RELEVANCE, COHERENCE, EFFECTIVENESS, EFFICIENCY, PROCESS As For (Outcome evaluation) the main driver that will be used is IMPACT & SUTUINABILITY.	All criteria requirements are to be covered as per the TOR. The focus areas can be discussed upon selection.
4	08-04-2021	According to the TOR Page 1 : "The key target group are Syrian youth who are displaced and living as refugees in Jordan but also vulnerable young Jordanians who have been massively affected by the conflicts in the region" and Page 3 : Interviews: The evaluator will conduct interviews with a minimum of 46 stakeholders a. What is the sampling frame for both dskey target group? Or how is the interviews divided between the two target group?	This will need to be developed by the consultant after meeting with RYSE and conducting the desk review.
5	08-04-2021	We would like to inquire about the possibility for a france/swiss based company that would include jordanians as part of the team, will our proposal be considered or should the company be registered in Jordan?	Your company can apply to the consultancy if the consultancy team is based in Jordan and can speak English and Arabic language fluently to conduct the interviews with the different stakeholders.

6	15-04-2021	<p>For this consultancy, we intended to staff some members of our permanent team who are based in Beirut and travel regularly to Jordan, and one freelance consultant who regularly works with us, who is Jordanian and based in Jordan. Would that be eligible ?</p>	<p>A bidder can apply if they have their consultancy team in Jordan. In your case you don't have the whole team however you can still apply and this will be considered in the evaluation in relation to other bidders.</p> <p>This is linked to challenges related to Covid 19 and any restrictions related to it where it is easier if the consultancy team is in Amman. Nevertheless, you can include in your proposal how you plan to implement the consultancy in light of this</p>
